## Purpose

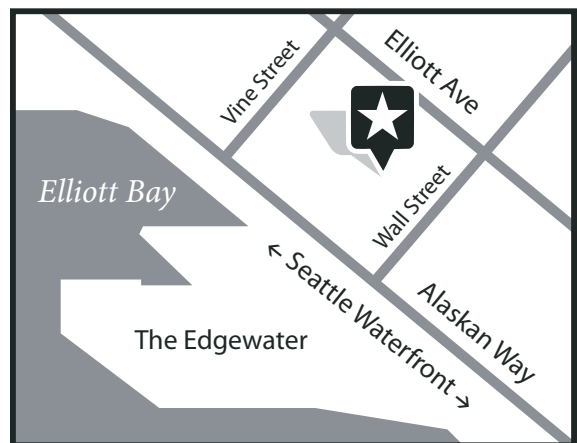

In this one hour meeting you will have an opportunity to hear two speakers from the Sexaholics Anonymous fellowship and two speakers from the S-Anon Family Groups, a 12-Step program for anyone affected by the sexual behavior of a family member or friend. You will be able to ask questions of members from each program and receive information about the programs which you can use to refer those you work with to the SA and/or S-Anon fellowships.

Those professionals, who work with sex addicts, or sexaholics, share a common purpose with Sexaholics Anonymous—to help the sexaholics recover and lead healthy, productive lives.
